A nice day, a huge crowd, and a very good set of cattle made for a great sale for Gill Red Angus. 2007 marks the 28th year this family has been raising Registered Red Angus Seed stock. The quality of the cattle continues to grow the number of folks in the seats. Eight states represented the buying crowd, with many repeat customers buying Gill Red Angus seed stock again. This operation is committed to their customers by actively bidding on and buying calves from their customers, along with several other customer services. They take pride in the quality of cattle they raise. These cattle will work for both the commercial rancher on grass and the feeding industry. Again this year their rib eye measurements were above industry average measuring 1.05 square inches of rib eye to every hundred pounds of body weight. Their cattle are all deep sided and easy fleshing and have the ability to put on weight gain very easily. Ron Bolze from the National Red Angus office, feedlots, sale barn owners, and a Meyer Natural Angus representative were all on hand to discuss all of the different marketing opportunities for the commercial rancher.

Lot 1 - LMG Gills Boa 6555 commanded \$7,250 for two-thirds interest and full possession from repeat customers Dan and Tara Hooper, Merriman, Ne. He was born on May 19, 2006 and is sired by LMG Gills Rattler 3555. His EPDs are .9 37 71 12 31 10 .05 .19, while he scanned a REA/cwt of 1.12 square inches which was a 116 ratio, and a 138 IMF Ratio. Plus he had performance ratios of 110 for weaning and 113 for yearling respectively.

Bringing \$6,000 was Lot 88 - LMG Gills Heavens Door 6577. This May 17, 2007 son of SRN Heavens Door 2095 sold to repeat customer, Franklin O'Driscoll, Selina, Ut. His EPDs are 3.2 51 80 15 12 -.11 .15. He has ratios of 116 for weaning and 110 for yearling.

Schmitz Red Angus, Sauk Rapids, Mn bid \$5,750 to own Lot 3 - LMG Gills Vaquero 6556. He is sired by LCC Vaquero 1412J and was born on June 5, 2006. His dam is a top cow for Gill Red Angus. She has a MPPA of 110 and is out of Rambo 502. His EPDs are .9 39 79 17 37 10 -.06 -.12. He has a weaning ratio of 111, yearling ratio of 116, IMF ratio of 107 and REA ratio of 105.

Tyler Messner, Sheyenne, ND purchased a couple bulls with the first one being Lot 2 - LMG Gills Advance 6600 for \$5,000. He was born on May 22, 2006 and is sired by RBJR Advance A709. His EPDs are 4 40 71 12 32 10 .00 .04. His ratios are, weaning 105, yearling 109, IMF 106, and REA 103. He also selected Lot 4 - LMG Gills Carolina 6524, a son of LMG Gills Monument 4562. His EPDs are 2.1 26 53 18 31 12. Messner also purchased the top selling bred commercial females selecting 15 head for \$1,500.

From Douglas, Wy, Dana Fitzhugh, selected two of the top selling bulls. At \$4,750 was Lot 37 - LMG Gills Carolina 6559 a May 26, 2006 son of LMG Gills Monument 4562. This guy had herd bull written all over him. His EPDs are 2.1 40 81 19 39 12. He also selected one for \$4,500. He was Lot 18 - LMG Gills Run Cloud 6507. He is an embryo transplant bull that was born on March 24, 2006 son of Hammel Run Cloud 525 and out of the great donor cow LMG Gills Dynette 902. His numbers are -.3 34 57 20 37 12 -.02 -.03

Repeat customer, Rapid Creek Ranch, Belvedere, SD paid \$4,750 for Lot 42 - LMG Gills Carolina 6573 which is sired by LMG Gills Monument 4562. His EPDs are .5 19 45 15 25 12. He scanned a REA/cwt of 1.04 square inches and had an IMF ratio of 121. They also gave \$4,500 for lot 15 - LMG Gills Addiction 6570. He is a June 5, 2007 son of DKK Addiction N10. His EPDs are -.9 25 39 24 36 11 .02 .03. He had a 140 IMF Ratio.

John Owens, Red Bluff, Ca paid \$4,500 for Lot 58 - LMG Gills Addiction 6700. This is a son of DKK Addiction N10 and was born on May 27, 2006. He had everything put together right and his EPDs are near perfect with a .5 39 64 22 41 11 .02 .05. He weaned off at 804 lbs with a ratio of 120 and yearling ratio of 115 an IMF ratio of 143 and a REA ratio of 123, while he measured out a 1.17 square in REA per hundred pounds of body weight.

Wallace Wock of Dickinson, ND selected the next high selling bull, lot 35 - LMG Gills Rattler 6536 sold for \$4250. He was born on May 17, 2006 and is a VGW Rattler 908 son. He is a big stout bull that is

stacked with performance. His EPDs are 2.5 41 73 15 35
9 -.01 -.09. He has a 109 weaning ratio, 113 yearling ratio, 103
IMF ratio, and a 102 REA ratio.

John Knutson, Quinn, SD gave \$250 for Lot 44 - LMG Gills Combo 6557.
This is a real deep, correct made bull. He is a son of MLK Crk
Combination 4149 and was born on June 13, 2006. His EPDs are -4.2
